

Start Here	<p>Before getting started, you must understand the rules of the activity:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Read each challenge carefully, and complete it exactly as it's written. 2. Challenges are completed by taking photos, videos or submitting text responses as directed. 3. When a challenge requires the entire team to be in a photo, it is understood that one person must snap the photo and will not be in it. 4. Challenges may be completed in any order and are worth different point values, so you will need to strategize to complete as many as possible within the time limit. <p>Once you've read and understand the rules, type OK to get started.</p>	Text	1

Ambidextrous	<p>Record a 5-second video of a teammate legibly signing their name using both hands at the same time. Keep video to under 5 seconds for ease of upload.</p>	Video	40
Animal House	<p>Who is currently taking care of three or more breeds of pets at home? Take a photo with that person showing a photo of at least one of their pets and write their name in the caption space.</p>	Photo	20
Artistic Flair	<p>Have the most artistic person on your team draw a caricature of a teammate. Then snap a photo of the subject holding up the drawing of themselves. Review the guidelines at the link below to make sure all required caricature features are included in the drawing. Drawing Caricature</p>	Photo	50
Balls in a Box	<p>The first box has two white balls. The second box has two black balls. The third box has a white and a black ball. All boxes are labeled but all labels are wrong! You are allowed to open one box, pick one ball at random, see its color and put it back into the box without seeing the color of the other ball. Brain Locker	At a high school with one thousand lockers and one thousand students, on the first day of class the principal asks the first student to go to every locker and open it. Then he has the second student go to every second locker and close it. The third goes to every third locker and, if it is closed, he opens it, and if it is open, he closes it. The fourth student does this to every fourth locker, and so on. After the process is completed with the thousandth student, how many lockers are open?	Trivia	70
Career Switch	Who has completely changed careers? Take a photo with that person and enter their name and previous career in the caption space.	Photo	20
Celebrity Doppelganger	Find someone in the room who looks like a celebrity or other famous person and snap a photo of that person holding up an image of the celebrity in the shot.	Photo	40
Coin Trick	Take a 5-second video of one team member performing this coin trick. The team member must place a coin on the back side of their hand, toss it in the air, and catch the coin in the same hand while keeping their palm facing down at all times. Keep video to under 5 seconds for ease of upload.	Video	20
Commonalities	Determine your team's most unique commonality. Once you figure out the most unique thing your group has in common, write a rap or rhyme about it of at least 4 lines. Then record a 5-second video of a teammate performing it. Keep video to under 5 seconds for ease of upload.	Video	20

Into the Wild	<p>Who has gone on vacation/holiday to a place inaccessible by road, where they had to be dropped off by plane or boat? Take a photo with that person. Enter their name and the name of the place in the caption space.</p>	Photo	10
It's All in the Name	<p>Make an anagram of your team's name and the name of an iconic celebrity to make up a phrase or a new name. Write it down and snap a photo of the answer. All letters MUST be used.</p>	Photo	30
