Tip of Your Nose	Who on your team can make their eyes go cross-eyed? Apparently looking at the tip of your noes will do the trick! Snap a photo of a teammate doing it.	Photo	20
To Boldly Go	Find the biggest Star Trek fan in your team and snap a photo of them doing the Vulcan salute.	Photo	10
Tongue Sniffer	Find someone who can touch their nose with their tongue and snap a photo of them doing it.	Photo	30
